**Memorial Mass for Fr. Art MacKinnon**: Fr. Art MacKinnon, a young man from New Victoria, Cape Breton, was a Scarboro Missionary. He was murdered on June 22, 1965 in the Dominican Republic where he was ministering as Pastor. Fr. Art was opposed to the military Junta running the Dominican Republic that was in power. Seeing the injustices being carried out; he successfully organized a strong populist opposition to the dictatorship. One evening, Fr. Art received a sick call and was being escorted by two locals to answer the purported call. He was found later, shot dead on the side of the road. In his efforts to relieve the suffering of the people, he sacrificed his life. Please join us for a Mass in honour of Fr. MacKinnon at the Parish of Saint Leonard, New Waterford on June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 7 pm. Members of the K.O.C. will also be in attendance to celebrate Fr. MacKinnon's heroic life.
