For Your Information: regarding St. Theresa's Hall and Alex LeBlanc:

Alex is the Property Manager for St. Theresa's Hall and he is also the Property Manager for the Glebe House and the Church. Alex is not running a business. He is an employee of the Parish and he works an 8-hour shift each day. Under the provincial labour laws, Alex is entitled to have all statutory (legal) holidays off with pay and the Hall is closed as there is no other employee to manage the hall in his place. Alex also has a right to a 24-hour "rest period" within every 7 days of work. In other words, he gets his "Sunday" each week. Alex also gets 4 weeks of vacation per year. During the times when Alex is not working the hall is closed. I have instructed Alex to arrange hall bookings and his other responsibilities so that they are conducive to his daily 8-hour shift. Furthermore, the Hall Committee and I have decided that, from now on, all late night hall events will end at 12:00 AM at which time everyone must leave the building so that Alex can close the Hall and go home. If there is bar service at the event, then the bar closes at 11:30 pm. Fr. Evo DiPierro
